

CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing or Disability)

Traineeship

The Certificate III in Individual Support traineeship will provide you with the factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concepts and practices required to provide personcentered care.

You will develop skills in:

- Providing individualised care while supporting independence and wellbeing
- Communication skills in a health or community services setting
- Working safely, legally and ethically
- Infection control
- Supporting community participation and social inclusion (Disability)
- Facilitating the empowerment of older people (Ageing)
- Providing support to people living with dementia (Ageing)

To study this course, you will need:

- To be employed under a contract of training (12 months full time or part time equivalent)
- To be physically fit and able to undertake manual handling and lifting in a safe environment
- To commit to weekly online study in addition to scheduled structured classes
- Access to (and ability to use) a computer, with word processing application (such as MS Word or Google Docs), Adobe Acrobat Reader DC, an internet connection and an email account
- To attend an information session which includes assessment of suitability and Language Literacy and Numeracy skills

Participants can achieve a Statement of Attainment or the full CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing or Disability). (superseded - transition in progress)
