CHC43115 Certificate IV in Disability Traineeship

The Certificate IV in Disability traineeship will provide you with the factual, technical and procedural knowledge to empower people with disabilities to achieve greater levels of independence and wellbeing, and supervise and/or coordinate a small team.

You will develop the skills to:

- Develop and provide person-centered service responses
- Facilitate the empowerment of people with disability
- Facilitate community participation, social inclusion and ongoing skills development
- Manage legal and ethical compliance
- Communicate using augmentative and alternative communication methods
- Working with people with mental health issues

Throughout your traineeship you will undertake 14 units of training to meet the requirements of the nationally recognised qualification CHC43115 Certificate IV in Disability.

Progress in each unit will be made by developing and applying your skills in the workplace and via our simulated business. Our friendly trainers will be available to support and guide you through your learning and assessment requirements and will visit your workplace for training/assessment activities and consultation.

To study this course, you will need:

- To be employed under a contract of training (24 months full time or part time equivalent)
- Sufficient language, literacy and numeracy skills to undertake training (assessed at enrolment)
- To be physically fit and able to undertake manual handling and lifting in a safe environment
- Allocated time during work hours to dedicate to training and assessment, this will be negotiated with your employer
- Access to and ability to use a computer, with word processing application (such as MS Word or Google Docs), Adobe Acrobat Reader DC, an internet connection and an email account

Participants can achieve a Statement of Attainment or the full CHC43115 Certificate IV in Disability
